



Summer 2019 Education Internship at the Children's Creativity Museum

Organizational Description:

The Children's Creativity Museum in San Francisco is an innovative art and technology experience for children ages 2-12 and their families. Our mission is to nurture creativity and collaboration in all children and families. We believe that creative expression, innovation, and critical thinking are core to fostering the next generation.

Commitment:

- Minimum 14 hours per week (9:30- 4:30 two days per week)
- Orientation is Tuesday, May 28th
- The first day is Wednesday, May 29th
- Applicants must be able to commit to the full internship from May 28th through September 1st, 2019
- In addition to Orientation, mandatory training and professional development workshops will be held on four different Mondays: June 3th, June 10th, June 17th and June 24th (10am-4pm)

Compensation:

- Unpaid: college credit when applicable

General Responsibilities:

- Assist with and facilitate Creative Group Workshops (Educational programming for Summer camps that visit CCM)
- Assist with CCM Summer Camp programming and special workshops
- Work with Educators during General Admission hours to teach basic, intermediate and advanced art and technology skills to youth and families
- Prepare, maintain and troubleshoot equipment and supplies in the exhibit/production areas; identify and report status of exhibits and supplies
- Responsible for opening and closing the museum floor and reporting on all issues related to running the museum.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Strong interest in art, education, museum studies, or media studies strongly desired
- Experience working with children

- Good computer skills on both Macs and PCs, working knowledge of media arts applications and the ability to learn and teach new software
- Strong written and oral communication skills
- Fluency in Spanish, Mandarin, Cantonese, or Tagalog a plus
- Experience working with families and community groups, particularly in the San Francisco Bay Area strongly desired
- Must have earned or currently be pursuing a Bachelor's degree

- The last day to apply is Tuesday May 21st, 2019
- Promising applicants will be invited for an interview and tour of the Children's Creativity Museum
- Orientation will be Tuesday, May 28th

Applicants must be able to commit to the full internship from May 28th through September 1st, 2019. Monday professional development days are mandatory, along with with a minimum 14 hours (two full days Tuesday - Sunday (half days are also accepted)).
